Telehub set to trial 'live' training sessions for care home staff

In an exciting development, our telehub is to launch a series of online training and education sessions for care home staff. The idea is all about extending and testing out the technological capabilities of our telehub to benefit those working and living in care homes in new ways.

We are grateful to all those care homes which have agreed to be part of our new initiative to test the use of telehub technology in the training and education of care home staff.

The programme will launch in May and among the initial training topics tailored for care home staff will be preventing pressure ulcers and improving the care of people with them; preventing falls; and nutrition.

Assuming that this initiative proves a success, the next stage will be to develop a curriculum of training and education. We like to do this in partnership with care homes and other key stakeholders in our vanguard.
