Airedale invited to spearhead India digital healthcare mission

THE work of our vanguard and the Airedale Digital Health Hub is to be showcased next week on an international stage. We are one of just a handful of NHS organisations invited to take part in a UK Trade and Investment mission to India. Our nurse consultant Rachel Binks will be sharing our success story at the Smart Cities Healthcare conferences staged in Delhi and Mumbai. The Indian Prime Minister and the Chairman of NHS England will be among those in attendance.

The event provides an opportunity for us to give an insight into the successes we are achieving through telemedicine in general, and our vanguard in particular. It is also a platform for forging closer links with people at the heart of Indian healthcare and exploring ways in which we can share our expertise with them and work together to improve their population health.

We have been invited to present at the conferences as part of the session looking at initiatives that are “Transforming hospital and emergency care”.



Rachel will also be taking part in a roundtable discussion involving the Indo-UK Institute of Health and Professor Sir Malcolm Grant, Chairman of NHS England.

There is also a panel discussion planned at each venue looking at the “Contrast between India and the UK in digital healthcare”, where our expertise is also expected to come to the fore.
